VIENNA DESIGN WEEK Anniversary Tour – Křehký Mikulov

On the occasion of its 20th anniversary, the VIENNA DESIGN WEEK is embarking on a Europe-wide tour: the third stop takes the festival to Křehký Mikulov, together with glass artist **Eva-Maria Zangerle** and sculptor **Rainer Grilberger**. The motivation behind this tour is to bring the festival's spirit beyond Austria's borders, connecting people, objects, and stories.

In the Stucco Hall, VIENNA DESIGN WEEK is presenting Zangerle and Grilberger's project **Caterina (I.O.U. <3)**, which moves between functional object and sculpture. It simultaneously unites craftsmanship, materiality, and hospitality by inviting viewers to interact with it.

For the vernissage, VIENNA DESIGN WEEK is activating **Caterina (I.O.U. <3)** by serving drinks in **Alpha** glasses by **Lobmeyr** — a local connection, as the glassworks are based near Mikulov. A limited number of the glasses will be altered from their original state beforehand by Zangerle and Grilberger, deformed, and translated into new contexts.
